COVID-19 is Affecting Everyone

Need a little help paying or reducing
your monthly electric bill?

There is federal economic assistance available.

Subsidy:

Households must meet income and
eligibility guidelines.

***YOU COULD RECEIVE UP
TO \$200.***

Crisis:

Households must meet eligibility guidelines and be in a home energy crisis
situation (have a disconnect notice, an eviction notice for non-payment of rent if
electric costs are included as an undesignated portion of rent or within 10 days
of running out of pre-paid electric. ***YOU COULD RECEIVE UP TO \$600.***

- If eligible, households may qualify for both programs (benefit amount is based on an income).
- If a household has a zero (0) balance on their electric bill they are still encouraged to apply. Assistance will be applied towards your next bill(s).
- **HOMEOWNERS AND RENTERS:** During this time of uncertainty, we recognize many people are facing economic hardship. Energy Assistance pays a portion of your bill. Guidelines have changed that may help you qualify for the program. We're here to help. Phone applications are fast and easy.
